Thanks to a partnership with more than 400 tourism offices in Europe and the EDEN Network (Sustainable Destinations awarded by the European Commission), **thanks to your trust and cooperation, European Best Destinations is, for the tenth year in a row, the most visited website dedicated to travel in Europe.**

Tourism has recovered everywhere in Europe, but where do travellers from all over the world want to spend their next holidays among an offer of city break destinations, nature, beach destinations?

Among + 400 European Destinations promoted on Europe destinations - including 90 sustainable EDEN Destinations awarded by the European Commission - **21 shortlisted destinations have been selected** for their growth of popularity on social networks during the past 12 months, growth of visitors, quality of life, sustainable development, all-year round cultural offer.

The **20 most voted of them will be promoted during the whole year 2023 to millions of travellers** among the Best Destinations to visit in Europe on the most visited website dedicated to culture and travel in Europe www.europeanbestdestinations.com

This year we have collected **a record of 686,244 votes from 178 countries** (528,069 for the 2022 edition of this event). The voting page has been shared a record **+ 193,000 times on social networks during the past 21 days** (122,000 shares for the 2022 edition of this event).

The 20 Most voted destinations win the right to use the "European Best Destinations 2023" title...

Our competitions for the European Best Destinations of the year, European Best Christmas Markets, European Best Beaches, Most Romantic destinations, European Best Ski Resorts, Best Beaches,... have become the **most important tourism competitions in Europe**; they bring together millions of travellers who support and discover the most beautiful destinations in Europe.

They also have an impact in "real life" with **significant growth of tourists** for our rewarded destinations with + 17% in growth of tourism for Porto rewarded in 2017, + 13% for Bordeaux rewarded in 2015, + +41% for Zagreb, European Best Christmas Market 2016-2017-2018, +18% for Budapest, + 10 millions of media coverage for Ljubljana European Best Destination 2022.

Like every year the competition was fierce with only 21 days of online votes from 20th January to 10th February to determine the ranking of the trendiest destinations in Europe that will be **promoted throughout the year to millions of travellers** and will be able to display the title "European Best Destinations".

HERE ARE SOME **IMPORTANT FIGURES:**

- 48% of the votes are from Europe, 52% are from outside Europe. This is the **largest proportion of votes outside Europe since the creation of this event**. This year more than ever, foreign travellers show a strong interest in travelling to Europe.
- The destination that comes in first place is the preferred destination of **American, Irish, Austrian, English and Australian travellers**.
- The Green Capital **Ljubljana won the 2022** edition of this competition and enjoyed a [global promotion of + 10 million euros](#) - This year's Green Capital shortlisted was **Grenoble Alpes** known for its commitment to slow mobility, sustainable tourism, culture, it has been voted among the 10 Best European Destinations as well as among the [Best Street Art Destinations in Europe](#).
- Two German Destinations were on board, Mannheim that will host the Bundesgartenschau 2023, awarded the title of [Best Event 2023](#) as well as Essen awarded past winter the title of [Best Christmas Market in Germany](#).
- **This year's winner** is a destination that collected **a record of 142,081 votes** (+66,439 votes regarding past year winner - it is a **record of votes since the creation of this competition** – last record of votes was for Porto and its 138,116 votes in 2017).

- The destination on the first place received 68% of votes outside its own country (32% from inside its borders). **Without its national votes it would still have been elected best European destination 2023.** As every year awarded destinations it received a worldwide support to reach the first place.
- The first traveller of this 2023 edition voted at 00.00.02 sec for Warsaw, the last traveller voted this February 10 at noon for Athens.
- 32,8% of voters came directly from social networks.
- **The voting page has been shared more than 195,000 times on social networks** in 21 days.
- Reported to its population **Cittadella** is the destination which collects the greatest number of votes (54,528 votes for 20,157 inhabitants), showing that a small destination can rise to the best places in a European ranking.
- In addition to being on the Podium of the 3rd Best Destinations to visit in Europe in 2023, Maribor has been voted [Best Culinary Destination in Europe](#).
- Athens is for the 2nd time in the top 3 favourite destinations of travellers, it is also awarded among the Best Street Art Destinations in Europe. **Greece** is the most searched country on EBD during the past 12 months and **is awarded #1 [Best Country to visit in Europe](#)** with #2.Portugal #3.Italy, #4Spain, #5France (based on visits and searches made on www.europeanbestdestinations.com during the last 12 months – past year winner was Portugal).

- For its 10th participation Vienna is ranked in the top 5 of the Best Destinations in Europe by travellers.
- Veszprém, voted among the 10 Best Destinations to visit in Europe is also awarded by the EU the title of European Capital of Culture (EU Commission) and has been voted Best Destination to visit in Hungary in 2023 and [Best Family Friendly City Break in Europe](#).
- After Brexit and Covid, London is back in the top 10 favourite destinations of travellers.
- Athens, Rhodes, Milos, 3 Greek destinations are top listed by travellers among their 20 favourite destinations in Europe.
- Spain is following it with Toledo, Tossa de Mar and Soller. #Spain is also ranked in the #5 Best Countries to visit in Europe in 2023 (4th position, following Italy).
- Portugal is a top destination to visit in Europe (#2 most popular country on EBD) with this year 2 smaller but attractive destinations favoured by travellers: Porto Santo (Madeira Islands) and Faial (Azores - Sustainable Tourism).
- The positive feedback of this promotion is not only to the first awarded destination, Marbella enjoyed a global promotion of + 2 million euros in only 2 months following the 2022 edition and Destinations ranked in the top 10 as Dinant enjoyed tourist growths up to +30% thanks to this recognition.

The winning contenders of the coveted "Best European Destinations 2022" title will be promoted throughout the year to millions of travelers — and will be authorized to display the title "European Best Destination" in their marketing.

Ljubljana, Slovenia

Ljubljana, the capital of Slovenia, is a city for the curious and adventurous, a treasure trove of exciting secrets and natural joys.

The proudly green capital of Slovenia welcomes all travelers hungry for culture, art, entertainment and offers broad, green areas, which have made it a global example of environmental planning. Earlier than other European destinations, Ljubljana opted for a fully pedestrian historic center.

Colorful history and natural heritage combined with authentic charm, culture, cuisine and varied city life have placed this beautiful capital at the top of the list of best destinations.

Marbella, Spain

Marbella is known as the "capital of sun" in Europe. It's a preferred destination for travelers looking for relaxation, shopping, refined hotels and restaurants, as well as local handicrafts, golf, outdoor sports, champagne and refinement.

Amiens, France

A peaceful haven of canals and floating gardens that display one of the most beautiful and largest Gothic cathedrals in France, Amiens is also a place to take an extraordinary journey in the footsteps of Jules Verne.

Divided by the Somme River, the city also is well known for its medieval belfry. Shops and cafes line the old Quartier St.-Léu's narrow streets as floating market gardens ("hortillonnages") dot the city's canals.

Ideally located in the heart of the Paris-London-Brussels triangle, Amiens has been ranked as the fourth-greenest city in France and is the only French city to have three UNESCO heritage sites, including its imposing cathedral and stunning architecture.

The city was a source of inspiration for Jules Verne when he settled there in 1871. The famous author left his mark on the city and his influence is visible in many corners of its streets.

Amiens is home to an international garden festival around the famous floating Hortillonnages that has been voted the most beautiful City Park in Europe. The Hortillonnages, a 740-acre green paradise in the heart of the city, can be explored on foot, by bike, in a row boat, kayak or even on a paddleboard.

"Don't miss the must-see Musée de Picardie or hop on a bike and head to Amiens Zoo, a real island of biodiversity where endangered species are protected in the peace of nature," advises EBD.

Leuven, Belgium

Leuven, a picturesque city in the heart of Belgium, east of Brussels, is an ideal destination for an exciting all year round city break.

Thanks to its rich and varied offering in heritage, art, culture, science, beer, gastronomy and shopping, this centuries-old university town invites visitors to stroll and discover everything within walking or biking distance. A hip and urban vibe in an historical setting, guarantees to draw visitors into its vibrancy.

Leuven also nabbed first place in the Best Open-Minded Destinations in Europe, a ranking of destinations actively working on accessibility, social diversity, solidarity, tolerance and respect.

With car-free shopping streets, street markets offering local products, this is also the land of chocolate and well known for its rich history of breweries dating back to 1366, and includes a number of well-known beer-makers, among them the legendary and world-famous Stella Artois.

On a central square is the 15th-century town hall, guarded by its tall spires. The building is decorated with hundreds of statues of local figures, biblical characters and saints. Opposite, the late Gothic St. Peter's Church houses a "Last Supper" by the Flemish Primitive painter Dieric Bouts. Nearby, Oude Markt is a long square lined with bars and cafes.



Every year the European Best Destinations portal organizes the Best in Europe vote, to find the best destinations in Europe and in this thirteenth edition, 528,069 votes have been received from 182 different countries.

Leading the ranking is Ljubljana, the Best European Destination for 2022. The only Spanish representative on the list, Marbella, has been in second position.

CRETE (GREECE)

Crete is ranked 20th in the European Best Destinations ranking, with 1,001 votes in its favour. And it is that Greece is always a yes, in fact, we find two Greek destinations in the top 20: Crete (20th) and Athens (18th).

The largest of the Greek islands is the perfect hedonistic destination: the beauty of its beaches competes with that of the mountains and gorges while life passes quietly in the small fishing villages that dot this pearl bathed by the Aegean Sea.

The history and remains of the past are present in every corner: the palaces of Knossos and Phaistos, the cathedral of Agios Minas, the fortress of Heraklion...

Don't forget to immerse yourself in nature at the Balos Lagoon and Gramvousa Island, Lake Kournas, Spinalonga Island, the Cave of Zeus and of course, on its beautiful beaches.

VIENNA (AUSTRIA)

Vienna obtains 4,978 votes that place it in the 17th place. It is impossible not to fall in love with the charms of Vienna. The capital of Austria, one of the cities with the best quality of life in the world, is love at first sight. A competition was organized from January 20 to February 18 for the specialized site European Best Destinations. The goal was to select the settings of the different participants in order to leave the popular places in 2022. After taking into account the results of the 125,000 evaluations from 182 different countries, the platform was able to determine the 20 most popular destinations in Europe among a list of 400 places.

THE TOP 3, CONSISTS OF...

In the position of the ranking, we find with 75,042 votes, Ljubljana in Slovenia. A small European capital with art, 343,000 inhabitants, known for its large green spaces.

In second place, heading for Spain, in Barcelona. The seaside resort in southern Spain has a total of 61,402 votes. On the program: beaches as far as the eye can see, luxury shops and parties. A real pleasure.

Finally to complete the podium, Greater Paris with 58,114 votes. It would also be the favorite destination of the Chinese. Indeed, 26% of their votes would go to this city.

LJUBLJANA (SLOVENIA)
